Key Dates!

Friday, March 24: Read-A-Thon packets go home in backpacks.

Saturday, March 25: Read-A-Thon begins!

March 25 - April 9: Encourage your child to read often and every day!

Sunday, April 9: Read-A-Thon ends.

April 10 - 12: Turn in reading logs, pledge forms and donations in to the school office.

What Counts (and what doesn't)? Reading before & after school! Being read to counts! Reading instead of watching T.V. counts! Reading in the dark under the covers with a flashlight counts... But only is your parents say it's ok. BUT... Reading during class time does NOT count (unless you're in the Library, which does count!). Watching the movie based on the book does NOT count. And time spent reading before and after the official Read-A-Thon dates do NOT count.

*Fun tip for older students - If you read to a younger sibling or friend it counts for both of you!!

There are Prizes!

Grand Prize: the Top fundraiser and Top Reader (most hours read) will win the grand prize

Grade Level: the Top Reader from each grade level will win a prize Top Class: the class that raises the most donations will win a class party

Raffle: For every \$10 a student raises they will be entered into a drawing for lots of different prizes
